

## Rector's Decree no. 132/2020

## CALL FOR APPLICATION TO SINGLE COURSES A.Y. 2020-2021

## THE RECTOR

**Given** the Law no. 264/1999 "Regulations on access to University

courses";

**Given** the Decree no. 270/2004 "Amendments to the regulation

containing dispositions on the didactic autonomy of the

Universities";

**Given** the Statute of UniCamillus;

**Given** the Didactic Regulations of UniCamillus;

Given the various Decrees of the Minister of the University, which defined,

among other things, the slots available for the degree courses, with restricted access, in Medicine and Surgery and in the health professions

for previous academic years at this University;

**Given** The Tuition Fees and Contributions Regulations for the academic

year 2020/2021 approved by the Organizing Technical Committee of UniCamillus on October 15th 2019;

## **DECREES**

Students aiming at professional development, curricular integration and cultural enrichment can register to single courses in the six-year Degree Courses in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics of UniCamillus of the  $1^{st}$  year, without being enrolled in the Degree Course itself, sitting the related exam and receiving a formal statement. The following categories of people can apply:

- 1) students enrolled in foreign universities;
- students enrolled in other universities in the national territory, subject to the authorization of the University they are attending or in application of specific agreements;
- 3) those who are graduated or holding the required qualification for the enrolment in the University degree courses;
- 4) those who are graduated but not holding the curricular requirements for the admission to a master's degree course, in order to integrate these requirements, as described by the admission call;
- 5) students enrolled in one of the UniCamillus degree courses. UniCamillus student can enroll for a maximum of two single courses of other UniCamillus Degree Courses. The successful completion of the related exams does not contribute to the achievement of the credits required for

the achievement of the degree the student is enrolled in, and is not considered in the average grade, but it is added to the student's career.

For students enrolled in foreign Universities the certificate attesting the qualification must be translated and legalized by the competent diplomatic or consular authorities.

The application for the admission to single courses (to be filled out according to the attached form), complete with all the required documentation, must be received by the Registrar's Office by certified e-mail to be sent to <a href="mailto:office.unicamillus@pec.it">office.unicamillus@pec.it</a> before the course starts and in any case no later than 22nd March 2021.

Upon expiry of the deadline for submission of the admission application, candidates will be contacted by the Registrar's Office by e-mail for the communication of the outcome of the admission request and the related procedures. Considering the limited number of available slots, applications will be evaluated in order of arrival until the coverage of all available slots.

The tuition fees for the single Course include:

- 1. a contribution of 250.00 Euros for administrative fees;
- a contribution per academic credits (CFU) calculated on the basis of the yearly cost of the related Degree Course (the table showing tuition fees can be found in the website at the link <a href="https://www.unicamillus.org/regulations/">https://www.unicamillus.org/regulations/</a> (Tuition Fees Regulations for Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics for the a.y. 2020-2021) divided by 60 (CFU scheduled for each academic year).

The tuition fees are non-refundable unless the student is not admitted to attend the single course.

The activation of the single course and the related slots are in any case subject to the approval of the Academic Institutions of the University.

For any matter not provided for in this call for application please refer to the Statute and Regulations governing the functioning of the University's activities. For the legal and interpretative purposes, the text of the Call for application approved with Rector's Decree no. 132 of 23rd December 2020, deposited at the Registrar's Office and written in Italian, of which a certified copy can be obtained, shall prevail.
