CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR THE ADMISSION OF NON-EU STUDENTS TO THE SIX-YEAR DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY IN ENGLISH OF SAINT CAMILLUS INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES (UNICAMILLUS) FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020/2021

- GIVEN** the Didactic Regulations of Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences (UniCamillus);
- GIVEN** The Tuition Fees and Contributions Regulation for the academic year 2020/2021 approved by the Organizing Technical Committee of UniCamillus on October 15th 2019;
- GIVEN** the Law n. 168 of May 19th, 1989 on the foundation of the Ministry of the University and Scientific Research;
- GIVEN** the Law n. 264 of August 2nd, 1999, containing "Regulations on access to University courses" and subsequent amendments and integrations;
- GIVEN** the Law n. 189 of July 30th 2002 "Amendments on legislation on immigration and asylum" and subsequent amendments and integrations, and notably art. 26;
- GIVEN** the Decree n. 270 of October 22nd 2004 "Amendments to the regulation containing dispositions on the didactic autonomy of the Universities", approved with Decree of the Minister of University and Scientific and Technologic Research of November 3rd, 1999, n. 509;
- GIVEN** the Ministerial Decree of March 16th, 2007, which has established the classification of the Degree Courses;
- GIVEN** the resolution of the Organizing Technical Committee of October 15th 2019 approving the

CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR THE ADMISSION OF NON-EU STUDENTS TO THE SIX-YEAR DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY TAUGHT IN ENGLISH OF SAINT CAMILLUS INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES (UNICAMILLUS) FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020/2021

Article 1 – Available slots and admission requirements

Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences, hereunder referred to as UniCamillus, has published for the academic year 2020/2021 the public call for application for the admission to the First Year of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery taught in English.

100 (one hundred) slots are available for non-EU applicants residing abroad.

The number of slots available might change depending on what provided by the Decree of the Ministry of Education, University and Research (M.I.U.R.), in accordance with the Law of 2 August 1999, n. 264. The MIUR Decree may provide for the confirmation, increase or decrease of the slots specified in this call for application. The University will publish the related Ministerial Decree on its webpage.

Citizens from Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Helvetic Confederation, Republic of San Marino and Vatican City are treated as EU candidates and must refer to the related call for application. Equal treatment applies to the categories that – according to what is provided by art. 26 of Italian Law 30 July 2002, n. 189 and subsequent modifications and alterations – access the courses under the same conditions as the Italian students.

Applicants wishing to take the admission test for entry to the degree course in Medicine and Surgery must meet one of the following criteria:

- a secondary school diploma that gives access to the University, issued by a state or equivalent educational institution of the Italian education system in Italy or abroad;
- final qualification of secondary education issued by an institution belonging to a foreign school system, located in Italy or abroad, obtained following a course of at least 12 years of schooling;
- final qualification of secondary education obtained in a school system that includes 10 or 11 years of schooling, supplemented with one or two years of university, provided that all the exams scheduled for those academic years have been passed.

Candidates enrolled in the last year of secondary school at the state and private school institutions of the Italian education system, or at a foreign secondary education institution that allows the

achievement of a valid qualification for admission to courses of higher education of the Italian system can also apply to UniCamillus, provided that they achieve their qualification by the last expected date for the enrolment for the academic year 2020/2021, under penalty of non-usability of the admission test result.

Students already in possession of an academic degree (obtained in Italy or abroad) and those who come from another degree course are required to observe the same procedures indicated in this call for applications and take the admission test.

With regard to candidates who have obtained a High School Diploma, or are in their final year of High School, and have studied in a foreign institution, the related foreign qualifications are deemed valid only if accompanied by a Declaration of Value issued by the Italian diplomatic representation.

Candidates who do not possess or do not present the necessary qualifications within the deadlines indicated by the university, according to current legislation, will lose the benefit to enrol or forfeit their enrolment if already admitted and have no right to the refund of the amount paid.

With reference to the recognition of foreign qualifications, the University will take into account the indications provided by the Ministry of Education, University and Research "Procedures for entry, stay and matriculation of foreign/international students to courses of higher education in Italy for the academic year 2019/-2020" and subsequent amendments (<http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri>).

Article 2 – Application submission

For the entry into the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery candidates are required to take an admission test. Registration for the admission test will be possible from January 13th 2020 to April 30th 2020.

In order to complete the registration for the admission test, each candidate needs to register on the web portal <http://www.unicamillus.org/admission-test>, and follow the instructions. Once the candidate has registered on the UniCamillus Portal, there will be a link that will redirect him or her to the UCAt Website. The candidate must register on the UCAt Website in order to be able to book the exam.

The candidate is responsible for the information given when filling in the registration form. The presence of false, incorrect or omitted information results in the immediate exclusion from the test or, if already passed, the cancellation from the lists of those admitted.

With the submission of the registration form the candidates authorise UniCamillus to carry out checks at institutions and authorities that have issued or validated the qualifications declared.

In case of difficulty in the registration procedure, an e-mail can be sent to admission@unicamillus.org for assistance.

Article 3 – Admission test (UCATCamillus)

The admission test to the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery is the “UCATCAMILLUS” test.

UCATCAMILLUS is a computer-based test that must be taken at certified test centres (see annex 1) and lasts two hours.

The test consists of five separate sections to be passed within a set time and each consists of a series of multiple choice questions, whose evaluation is made according to the following table.

The overall assessment is obtained by summing the scores of the Verbal Reasoning, Decision-making, Quantitative Reasoning and Abstract Reasoning sections. The “Situational Judgement” section is not relevant for the final score. It is not possible to score below 300 or above 900 for

each section.

The admission test, entirely in English, must be taken between May 4th 2020 and June 10th 2020, considering the availability of the UCAT test centre chosen by the student, which must be contacted in good time in order to book the test date. A copy of the "score report" - given to the candidate on the same day of the test - must be communicated to UniCamillus to the email address score@unicamillus.org, no later than June 13th 2020, under penalty of exclusion from the ranking.

The UCATCAMILLUS test is managed by UKCAT CONSORTIUM, an independent structure from UniCamillus. The registration fee for the UCAT test must be paid directly to UKCAT CONSORTIUM according to the methods indicated on their website www.ucat.ac.uk.

Article 4 – Final ranking list

UniCamillus will draw up the final ranking based on the results of the UCATCAMILLUS test.

In case of a tie, the score obtained by the candidate in the different sections of "Verbal Reasoning", "Decision Making", "Quantitative Reasoning", "Abstract Reasoning", prevails in descending order. In the event of a further tie in the score, priority will be given to the younger candidate.

The final ranking, guaranteeing the anonymity of the candidates, will be published by June 17th 2020 on the website www.unicamillus.org.

Article 5 – Enrolment and re-ordering procedure

Candidates who have obtained a favourable position in the ranking for enrolment are required to register on the University web portal www.unicamillus.org starting from the publication of the final ranking up until July 3rd 2020. The procedure entails, under penalty of exclusion from the ranking, the payment of the first instalment of the university fee for an amount of €5.000,00 (five thousand).

Any slots not covered will be managed according to the following “reordering” procedure:

- Publication on the website www.unicamillus.org of the number of slots available for missing enrolments or withdrawals (reopening of the rankings);
- admitted candidates for the reordering of the ranking will have to pay the first instalment by 6 p.m. of the third day following the reopening of the ranking;
- the reordering procedure will be reiterated until the available seats are filled.

Candidates who do not meet the deadlines indicated above will be considered withdrawing candidates and will lose the right to enrol.

Article 6 – Enrolment completion

From July 7th 2020 until July 22nd 2020 the following documentation must be sent:

- Enrolment application (available online) addressed to the Rector and acceptance of the UniCamillus Code of Ethics;
- Student contract available online;
- Copy of identification document.

In order to complete the enrolment, students are required to submit at the Registrar's Office, by August 31st 2020, under penalty of exclusion, copy of the entry visa for study reasons obtained in accordance with the law.

In the case of qualifications obtained in a higher education institution abroad, students must send to the Admission Office, by September 18th 2020, an official legalized translation in Italian of their Diploma accompanied by a Declaration of Value issued by the Italian Embassy or Italian General Consulate competent for the territory in the country where the qualification was produced. Failure to do so will result in the exclusion of the student.

It is also mandatory to deliver by September 30th 2020 the following health certifications:

- tuberculin test performed according to the Mantoux technique or with the quantiferon test, according to the provisions of the Agreement February 7, 2013 of the State-Regions Conference on "Prevention of tuberculosis in health care workers and equivalent professionals", and by the D.P.R. n. 465 of 7.11.2001, Regulation establishing the conditions under which vaccination against tuberculosis is mandatory, in accordance with article 93, paragraph 2, of the law of 23rd December 2000, no. 388; said test must be performed at a S.S.N. (National Health Service) structure;
- certificate of vaccination against viral hepatitis B, according to Law n. 165 of 27.5.1991.

By October 9th 2020 the student must submit at the Registrar's Office, under penalty of exclusion from the Degree Course, the following additional documentation:

- Payment receipt of the regional tax (to be made directly to the Lazio Region).
- two passport-sized photographs (with the name and surname indicated on the back);
- application for the permit of stay issued by the competent authorities.

The candidate who renounces or who, however, does not complete the enrolment procedure within the time specified in this call for application, will not be reimbursed of the amount paid, under any circumstance, and will be considered automatically withdrawn.

Article 7 – Withdrawal procedure following enrolment

Students who, after completing their enrolment, wish to withdraw, will have to submit their request and send it via R/R registered mail to: UniCamillus University - Via di Sant'Alessandro 8 - 00133 Rome or by certified email PEC to unicamillus@pec.it.

The University reserves the right to ascertain the truthfulness of the declarations made by the candidate, in accordance with the current legislation. The candidate must therefore provide all the necessary elements to allow for the appropriate checks. In the event that the candidate does not submit further documents as requested, or in case the documentation provided contains false declarations, without changes to the penalties provided for by the penal code and by the special laws on the subject and the declarer's exposure to the action for damages by the other parties, the enrolment application – or the matriculation, if already made - will be cancelled, any benefits will be withdrawn and the tuition fees paid will be retained.

The University can request to the competent Authorities, including the diplomatic delegation of the Country of origin, the proof that the candidate has sufficient financial means for each month of the duration of the degree course, an accommodation during the studies and sufficient financial resources to come back to his country after the completion of the degree.

In case of withdrawal, at any stage, the amount paid for the payment of the first instalment of the university tuition is not refundable for any reason.

Once in Italy, the student must submit a "Certificate of suitability specific to their professional profile", issued by an occupational physician. On this point the University will provide useful information in order to obtain such certification.

The University reserves the right to change dates, times, testing location and publication dates of results, internship locations, both in the Region and out of the Region, and teaching methods, if it is deemed necessary for organizational reasons. The participation in the call for application implies the full and unquestionable acceptance of the provisions contained therein. For juridical and interpretative purposes, the Italian call for application, approved with Rector's Decree n. 1 of January 3rd 2020, filed and available at the academic office, shall prevail.

Article 9 – Supervisory Committee for the regularity of the competition

With a specific provision, a committee (composed of at least three effective members) will be appointed in order to ensure the regular and proper performance of the operative procedures of the competition.

Vittorino Testa, director of student services - UniCamillus University, is responsible for the procedure.
