The knowledge on complications and their prevention will be deepened. The educational objective of the Master is to develop specialized knowledge on the design and execution of the most recent oral implantology techniques as well as to acquire an in-depth knowledge of the safest and most modern techniques and technologies in the field of implant surgery.

Those who will complete the CPD 2nd level course in Oral Implantology will be able, independently of the laws in force in the various countries, to carry out their professional activity autonomously at private health facilities, in a dependent or free professional regime.
