MSc MEDICINE AND SURGERY

6 Years – 360 ECTS credits

In English 

Medical graduates can work as medical surgeons in many different professional fields (clinical, healthcare and biomedical). Career opportunities include: PhD studies; work at public and private clinics, GP practices, hospitals and specialized centres, national and international healthcare and humanitarian organizations; employment in universities and research institutions or specialisation schools.



BSc RADIOLOGY, DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING AND RADIOTHERAPY TECHNIQUES

3 Years – 180 ECTS credits

In English 

Radiology, Diagnostic Imaging and Radiotherapy Techniques graduates are specialists in procedures requiring the use of ionizing radiation sources, both artificial and natural, as well as thermal, ultrasonic, and magnetic resonance energies. Imaging and radiotherapy techniques are essential for the diagnosis, treatment and monitoring of various diseases.



BSc NURSING

3 Years – 180 ECTS credits

In English 

Nursing graduates are professionals who, throughout the process of care, maintenance, and/or recovery of health, are able to provide invaluable assistance to patients, offering technical, relational and educational support in healthcare facilities (both public and private), community settings, and at home, either as employees or as freelancers. Nurses also take part in advanced training programmes.



BSc BIOMEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNIQUES

3 Years – 180 ECTS credits

In Italian 

Biomedical Laboratory Techniques graduates are involved in biomedical analysis and biotechnological activity, particularly in the fields of biochemistry, microbiology and virology, pharmacotoxicology, immunology, clinical pathology, haematology, cytology and histopathology. They are professionals specialised in the analysis of biological samples and exclusively responsible for technical validation.

MSc DENTISTRY AND DENTAL PROSTHETICS

6 Years – 360 ECTS credits

In Italian 

Dentistry graduates can practise as dentists in various clinical, healthcare and biomedical professional roles and fields of expertise. They can also work in management roles within the National Health Service, following the rules and regulations established by the current laws.



BSc MIDWIFERY

3 Years – 180 ECTS credits

In Italian 

Midwifery graduates are responsible for assisting women throughout their entire life, up to old age, and for the prevention, diagnosis, care, preservation, and recovery of sexual and reproductive health in the fields of midwifery, neonatology, gynaecology and oncology. Their activities are aimed at women, couples, newborns, children, families and communities, and can take place in various contexts and healthcare settings.



BSc PHYSIOTHERAPY

3 Years – 180 ECTS credits

In English 

Physiotherapy graduates are responsible for developing and implementing therapeutic techniques for the rehabilitation of motor, psychomotor, and cognitive functions in patients. They may assess the need for the use and efficacy of prostheses and provide support to patients. Work opportunities include: healthcare facilities (both public and private), community settings, and at home, either as employees or as freelancers.
