

**Erasmus+  
FAQ- Frequently asked questions**

**1. What is Erasmus+ Programme for education purposes and which are the available destinations?**

The Erasmus+ program for education purposes is an European programme which allows students to carry out a period of study in Universities of one of the European countries belonging to the program. **2. What is the duration of the mobility for education purposes?**

Mobility can have a duration from a minimum of 2 to a maximum of 12 months. Students must spend at least 2 months (60 days) at the host University. If mobility duration is shorter, students must fully repay Grant's amount they received.

**3. Students can choose among many destinations and I only have three choices: how do I make a choice?**

The choice of your destinations must be made by evaluating your own linguistic level and the presence, at the foreign Universities, of courses with contents similar to those to be taken at UniCamillus University. Programs and contents of the courses can be found on the websites of the foreign universities.

**4. How can I apply?**

Accessing the GOMP student portal and following the directions provided in the Guide, you will be able to fill in and complete your application.

**5. How can I choose exams to be taken abroad? And how can I find out which exams will be recognized once I am back at UniCamillus?**

The choice of the exams to be taken abroad and the Italian exams that will be recognized after your return must be made basing on the list of courses offered by the foreign Universities and the exams included in the Italian study plan.

Students must contact Didactic Managers of their course of study for guidance and advice. Didactic Managers will guide them both in choosing foreign exams and in identifying Italian exams. They will help them to establish an abroad study program consistent with the Italian study plan and proportionate to the mobility period.

The established study programme must be "officialised" by filling in the Learning Agreement, a "didactic contract" between students, UniCamillus University and host Universities. It includes the list of exams to be taken abroad and the corresponding Italian exams. It also guarantees students the recognition of the established Italian exams.

If necessary, the Learning Agreement can be changed, even after arrival at the host University.

## **6. Will I be guaranteed an accommodation?**

Not every University can guarantee accommodations. If Universities have dedicated offices and university residences or apartments, they will provide information directly to students so that they can apply for admission. Otherwise, Universities may indicate dedicated websites or services, beyond University, to help students find some accommodation. Thus, in some circumstances, students are responsible for their own accommodation arrangements.

## **7. Are there any special procedures to enter the host country?**

Students must autonomously get informed about:

- any rules governing entry into the host country by contacting the relevant diplomatic representations (embassies and consulates) in Italy in due time;
- health care in the host country, by contacting the their ASL or diplomatic representations.

## **8. What is the OLS test?**

Erasmus+ Online Linguistic Support (OLS) assists participants in Erasmus+ Programme mobility activities with language learning. OLS offers participants the opportunity to test their foreign languages skills. In addition, selected participants can take an online language course to refine their skills.
