CALL FOR ADMISSIONS TO THE CPD SECOND-LEVEL COURSE IN IMPLANT DENTISTRY AT THE SAINT CAMILLUS INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES – UNICAMILLUS Academic Year 2023/2024

THE RECTOR

GIVEN the Statute of the Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences (UniCamillus);

GIVEN the Teaching Regulations of the Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences (UniCamillus);

GIVEN the University's CPD first- and second-level course Regulations approved by the Organising Technical Committee on 30th March 2023;

GIVEN the University's Code of Ethics and Organization, Management and Control Model no. 231;

GIVEN law no. 168 of 19th May 1989, concerning the establishment of the Ministry of University and Research (MUR);

GIVEN decree no. 270 of 22nd October 2004 "Amendments to the regulations concerning laws about the educational autonomy of universities", approved through the Decree of the Minister of University and Scientific and Technological Research no. 509 of 3rd November 1999;

HEREBY DECREES

Article no.1

The creation of a CPD second-level course entitled *Implant Dentistry*, run by the Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences (UniCamillus) for the academic year 2023/2024, whose call for admissions attached to this Decree constitutes an integral part.

Title	IMPLANT DENTISTRY
Objectives	The Master Program 'University Master in Implant Dentistry' (UMID) is designed for the general dentist who has already taken the first step towards the field of implantology. Through lessons on theory and hands-on participation activities the Masters course aims to help the student acquire specific proficiency and clinical experience in laser wavelengths principally used in dentistry. The clinical experience activities will be held in the new department of laser therapy and surgery, with live operations on patients performed by participants under the guidance and supervision of teachers. The course concludes with a Master's thesis on topics of implant that will prepare the student during the year and will discuss at the end of the course.

	Candidates with a degree completed abroad comparable in duration and content to an Italian
	degree required for admission to a CPD course may also apply. If this is the case, candidates
	must provide a declaration of value issued by the Italian consular authority in the country of
	study (accompanied by a transcript of records and a copy of the final diploma), or a Certificate
	of Comparability issued by CIMEA (accessing the CIMEA platform) with an accompanying
	Verification Certificate, or a Diploma Supplement (for European degree titles) issued by the
	university of origin and legalized at the Italian Embassy in the country of study. Candidates who
	do not possess or do not present an eligible degree certificate within 6 months of enrolment, in
	accordance with current regulations, forfeit their enrolment, if already admitted, and are not
	entitled to any refund.
	If the prescribed requirements are not met, the Teaching Services Office may, at any time and
	with a reasoned decision, exclude the candidate from the programme.

	To finalize the application, the following documentation must be provided and uploaded on to
	the portal during enrolment:

	of exclusion, the original official translation into Italian of the academic qualifications, complete
	with legalization and Declaration of Value issued by the Italian Embassy or Italian Consulate
	competent for the territory in the country where the degree was completed;

	C) photocopy of the health insurance card;
	D) digital passport photo (JPEG or PNG format);
	E) privacy information in accordance with EU Regulation no.2016/679 on "the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data" available on the GOMP portal, to be
	uploaded during enrolment;
	F) student contract available on the GOMP portal, to be uploaded during enrolment.

	Failure to pay the fee within the established time limit will result in the suspension of access to

	RIGHT OF WITHDRAWAL - If enrolment has been completed remotely or outside of the
	University itself, students may exercise the right of withdrawal within 14 (fourteen) days from the date of enrolment (the payment date will be taken as reference), and, as a result, unilaterally
	withdraw by clearly communicating to UniCamillus their wish to withdraw. This request must be
	sent by CEM to the address <u>postlaurea.unicamillus@pec.it</u> . UniCamillus will proceed to
	reimburse the amount paid within the following 14 (fourteen) days, retaining an amount
	equal to 5% of the amount paid for secretarial services and using the same payment method
	used by the student, unless indicated otherwise.
	Outside of the cases expressly provided for in this call for applications, no refund will be
	made under any circumstances.
	RIGHT TO LEAVE THE COURSE - By exercising the right to leave the course, students will no
	longer be allowed access to lectures or tools made available to them by UniCamillus.
	Students who wish to leave the course must submit a request through an online procedure
	by accessing the student portal (Gomp) with their credentials, by going to the
	"career>questions>request to leave the course" section.
	In case of withdrawal, no amount already paid up to the time of submitting the request will
	be refunded under any circumstances.
	Students wishing to leave the course after the start of lectures are still required to pay the full amount of fees, as prescribed.
	Participation in this call for admissions implies full and unquestionable acceptance of the
