Addresses of the course and admission requirements	<p>Candidates in possession of the following qualifications can participate in the Master:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bachelor’s and Master’s Degree pursuant to MD n. 270/2004; • Bachelor’s and Master’s Degree pursuant to MD n. 509/1999; • Degree earned according to previous regulations; <p>Candidates in possession of degrees earned abroad, equivalent for duration and contents to the Italian degree required to access the Master can apply as well.</p> <p>In the latter case, candidates must provide Declaration of Value, issued by the Italian Consular Authority of the country of study (together with “Transcript of Records” + duplicate of final degree) or CIMEA Statements of Comparability along with CIMEA Statements of Verification (through CIMEA platform) or Diploma Supplement (in case of European Degrees) issued by the University of origin and legalized by the Italian Embassy of the country of study.</p> <p>Candidates not having or not presenting adequate qualifications pursuant to current regulations within 6 months, forfeit their enrolment if already admitted and have no right to refunds of any amount paid to the University.</p> <p>In case of lacking of the aforementioned requirements, Didactic Administrative Office can exclude candidates from the Master at any time and with a justified provision.</p> <p>In accordance with Art. 142 of Royal Decree 1592/1933, simultaneous enrolment in different Universities and Institutes of Higher Education, in different Departments or Schools of the same University or Institute and in different degree courses or diploma courses of the same Department or School is prohibited.</p>
Activities and duties	<p>Teachings include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • video lessons on the learning platform; • supplementary teaching materials. <p>Students are required to accomplish the following duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • individual study of teaching materials; • passing the final exam.
Enrolment modalities	<p>To enroll in the Master, candidates who meet the above requirements must proceed with enrolment through the GOMP portal (https://unicamillus-studenti.gomp.it/Login/Index?ReturnUrl=%2fHome), following the information provided in the enrolment guide on UniCamillus website.</p> <p>In order to complete the enrolment, candidates must be in possession of the following documents and attach them to the portal during the enrolment stage:</p> <p>A) degree certification or certified copy of the degree or, provisionally, self-certification. Candidates with degrees obtained abroad must submit, under penalty of exclusion, the master copy official Italian translation of their degrees, along with legalization and Declaration of Value issued by the Italian Embassy or the Italian Consulate General in charge in the country where the degree was produced;</p> <p>B) duplicate of a valid identity document;</p> <p>C) duplicate of tax code or health card;</p> <p>D) digital photograph (JPEG o PNG);</p> <p>E) Privacy policy in accordance with Regulation (EU) n.2016/679 on "protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data" available on the GOMP portal, to be uploaded during the registration process;</p> <p>F) “Student Contract” available on the GOMP portal, to be uploaded during the registration process;</p>

	<p>For candidates with equivalent qualifications to those required: G) Declaration of Value, issued by the Italian Consular Authority of the country of study (together with "Transcript of Records" + duplicate of final degree) or CIMEA Statements of Comparability along with CIMEA Statements of Verification (through CIMEA platform) or Diploma Supplement (in case of European Degrees) issued by the University of origin and legalized by the Italian Embassy of the country of study. Candidates with incomplete documents are admitted with reserve and can not complete their enrolment until presenting all the required documents.</p> <p>Attention: enrolment will be considered completed only after payment of fees and secretarial fees.</p>
Course duration	<p>The Master lasts 1 year with 1500 hours of commitment, corresponding to 60 CFU (University Educational Credits) and ECTS (European Credit Transfer System).</p> <p>Teachings are delivered in e-learning mode on the teaching platform 24 hours a day.</p> <p>In order to earn this Master's Diploma, students must complete all the teaching courses, pass the final exam (consisting in a multiple choice test) and write a dissertation and discuss it in front of a dedicated Commission. . Students must earn this Master's Diploma within the maximum period of 2 years (since their enrolment), students must also be in order with taxes payment and academic contributions.</p>
Registration fees	<p>Registration fee for this Master course is € 3.600,00, plus € 70,00 for secretarial fees (including enrolment stamp duty and degree certificate issue stamp duty) to be paid in a single payment while enrolling.</p> <p>Registration will be considered completed only after finalizing the payment.</p> <p>Failure in paying the fee by the deadline will result in suspension of access to the platform and in non-admission to the final exam. Interruption of any kind in students' attendance to lessons and didactic activities does not exempt them from paying the remaining installments.</p> <p>RIGHT TO RECONSIDER - Within 14 (fourteen) days from the date of payment, students may exercise the right to reconsider. As a consequence, students unilaterally waive from their enrolment by explicitly communicating to UniCamillus their willing to waive. This request should be sent by certified email (CEM) to postlaurea.unicamillus@pec.it.</p> <p>In case of exercising this right to reconsider, UniCamillus will proceed to refund the paid amount within the following 14 (fourteen) days - withholding an amount of 5% of the paid sum for secretarial services - using the same means of payment previously employed by the User, unless expressly indicating a different means of payment.</p> <p>Except for mandatory cases, expressly stated in this announcement, no refund will be made under any circumstances.</p> <p>RIGHT TO WAIVE STUDIES - By exercising the right of abandonment or waiver of studies, students will no longer have access to any educational activity and/or qualification to use the tools UniCamillus puts at their disposal.</p> <p>Students wishing to waive must submit a waiver application using an online procedure. They must access the student portal (GOMP) with their credentials, visiting the "careers> applications> study waiver application" section.</p> <p>In case of waiver, the amounts paid until the moment of presentation of the waiver request will not be reimbursed under any circumstances.</p> <p>Students who waive or abandon their studies after the beginning of classes</p>

	are required to pay the whole amount of fees.

(the “Contract”)

BETWEEN

hereunder referred to as “Student”,

CONSIDERING

- The Law 2nd August 1999, n. 264, regarding “Regulations on access to university courses” and subsequent integrations and modifications;
- the Decree 927 of 28th November 2017 “Institution and approval of the non-statal University legally recognized” named «Saint Camillus International University of Health Sciences», also called «UniCamillus» in Rome;

PROVIDED THAT

the Student is required to read the Statute, the Announcement of the 1st Level On-line Master’s Degree, the Code of Ethics, and the Didactic Regulations and Documents posted on the University website, which detail the teaching methodologies, the Study Plan, the services provided, the rules for the delivery of said services, the evaluation criteria, the loss of student rights, the deadlines for the tuition fees, as well as the modalities for study withdrawal, discontinuation, or outgoing transfer.

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Art. 1 Adhesion

The student enrolled in the 1st Level On-line Master’s Degree Course subscribes to the services provided by the University and accepts them in the form in which they are provided.

Art. 2 Services

The enrollment in the University and the regular payment of the amounts due are the conditions required for the student to benefit of the related rights and services of the University for that Academic Year.

Art. 3 Student's obligations

The Student undertakes to actively take part in the activities promoted by the University, participating in all training activities related to the Course of studies - in compliance with the current laws or laws enacted as a result of emergency situations (e.g. Covid-19) -, including traineeship activities which might be included in the course.

The Student undertakes to fully respect the provisions of the Code of Ethics, the University Didactic Regulation, the Announcement of the 1st Level On-line Master's Degree, and the Didactic Regulations and Documents for the achievement of their own educational and professional purposes.

Art. 4 University contributions

The Student's University contribution is regulated by the Announcement of the 1st Level On-line Master's Degree published on the UniCamillus.

Art. 5 Duration of the Contract and Right of Withdrawal

The duration of this contract is equal to the official duration of the Master's Degree Course. In case the Student has obtained an extension with respect to the expiration date, the Contract will be tacitly renewed for the period in excess of the legal duration of the degree program.

If this Contract is concluded remotely or outside the University's grounds, within 14 (fourteen) days by the day of signing of this Contract (if the date is missing or is incorrect, the day of payment by the Student shall prevail), the Student may exercise their right to reconsider and unilaterally terminate the Contract communicating clearly to UniCamillus their will to terminate. The request must be sent by certified electronic mail at pstlaurea.unicamillus@pec.it or through a registered letter with notice of return (Raccomandata A/R) to be sent at: UniCamillus - Segreteria Master On-Line- Via di Sant'Alessandro 8 - 00131 Roma.

In case of exercising the right to reconsider, UniCamillus will proceed to refund the amount paid within the next 14 (fourteen) days - retaining for secretarial services an amount equal to 5% of the amount paid - using the same means of payment used by the User for payment unless a different means of payment is expressly indicated.

Art. 6 Abandonment of Studies or Study Waiver

The Abandonment, the Transfer and/or the Study Waiver are regulated in terms and conditions as provided by the present Contract, by the Tuition Fees and Contributions Regulations and by the Didactic Regulations published on the UniCamillus website.

Exercising the right of abandonment, waive, the Student will not have access to any didactic activity and/or title to use the tools provided by UniCamillus.

Those Students who want to quit their studies are required to submit a waiver request through the on-line procedure by accessing the Student's Portal (GOMP) with their log-in information, in the section "Careers>Applications> Application for withdrawal from studies".

In case of study waiver or outgoing transfer there will be no reimbursement to the Student, in any case, of the amounts already paid until the date of the submission of the waiver request.

The Student who waives or abandons her/his studies after the lessons started is required in any case to pay in full the expected amounts.

Art. 7 Ethical Code and Organization, Management and Supervision Model ex D. Lgs. 231

Given that UniCamillus adopted the Ethical Code and, pursuant to the principles and guidelines provided for by the legislative decree 231/2001, the Organizational Management and Supervision Model ex D. Lgs. 231 (from now on "Organizational Model 231") published on the website www.unicamillus.org, the Student explicitly declares to acknowledge the Ethical Code and the Organizational Model 231 adopted by the University UniCamillus, and commits to behave in accordance with the principles contained therein and in accordance with the legal provisions, and also to inform of all possible violations of the Ethical Code of the Organizational Model 231 of which they should become aware, as well as related protocols and procedures, directly to the Supervisory Board of the University UniCamillus, to the e-mail address odv@unicamillus.org.

Moreover, the Student acknowledges that in the case of non-observance of the abovementioned commitments in this declaration, UniCamillus may proceed with the resolution of the contract in accordance with and by art. 1456 c.c. notwithstanding the right to compensation for damages caused.

Art. 8 Communications with the University

Communications between the University and students via e-mail is regulated by the Electronic Mail Regulation and by the University Regulations published on the UniCamillus website.

Art. 9 Competent Court and ascribable discipline

In all disputes that may arise in order of validity, interpretation, execution or resolution of the Contract, the only competent Court is the one of Rome.

Given the nature of the University, the regulations contained in the legislative decree 206/05 and subsequent amendments and additions are not applicable or in any way referable to this contract with the Student.
