The facilitation of communication within the group and with the parents of patients has been the subject of psychological training with Prof. Salvatore Grimaldi, of the Rome University, from 2000 to 2002 and in which the undersigned has participated on a regular basis.

From May 21 to July 5, 2001, upon proposal of the Director of the Department, Prof. M. Orzalesi, the undersigned participated in the 1st Management Training Course organized by the Personnel Department of the Bambino Gesù Hospital in collaboration with R.S.O. and IRI Management, a training company that works with managers and professionals. During the latter, she was head of the coordination of six Italian Neonatology Centers participating in the project. Since 1999 she has been a member of the Committee for the Prevention of Hospital Infections. As part of this task, she proposed and contributed to the dissemination of protocols and guidelines for doctors and nurses for the prevention of hospital infections in the Children's Hospital Bambino Gesù.

As part of the neonatal Intensive Care activity, she has autonomously used equipment for neonatal mechanical ventilation, in the following ways: Controlled Intermittent Positive Pressure Ventilation (IPPV), Intermittent Mandatory Ventilation (IMV) and Synchronized Intermittent Mandatory Ventilation (SIMV), Synchronized Intermittent Positive Pressure Ventilation (SIPPV), Pressure Support Ventilation (PSV), Volume Guarantee Pressure Support Ventilation (PSV-VG), Proportional Assist Ventilation (PAV), High Frequency Oscillatory Ventilation (HFOV), also with

use of nitrogen oxide by inhalation. Autonomous execution of the following procedures: orotracheal intubation in laryngoscopy, in the delivery room, in newborn transport, in the NICU department and possible administration of exogenous surfactant by endotracheal route in neonates affected by hyaline membrane disease; positioning of central venous access by cannulation of peripheral vessels with percutaneous catheter, cannulation of umbilical vessels and subsequent intravenous therapy, including total parenteral nutrition, transfusion of blood products and exsanguinotransfusion; thoracentesis and drainage of pneumothorax and pleural effusions. Stabilization and assistance before and during the transport of pathological infants by STEN ambulance, including assistance in the delivery room.
